We respect and acknowledge their spiritual connection as the custodians of this land and that their cultural heritage beliefs are still important to the living people today.’

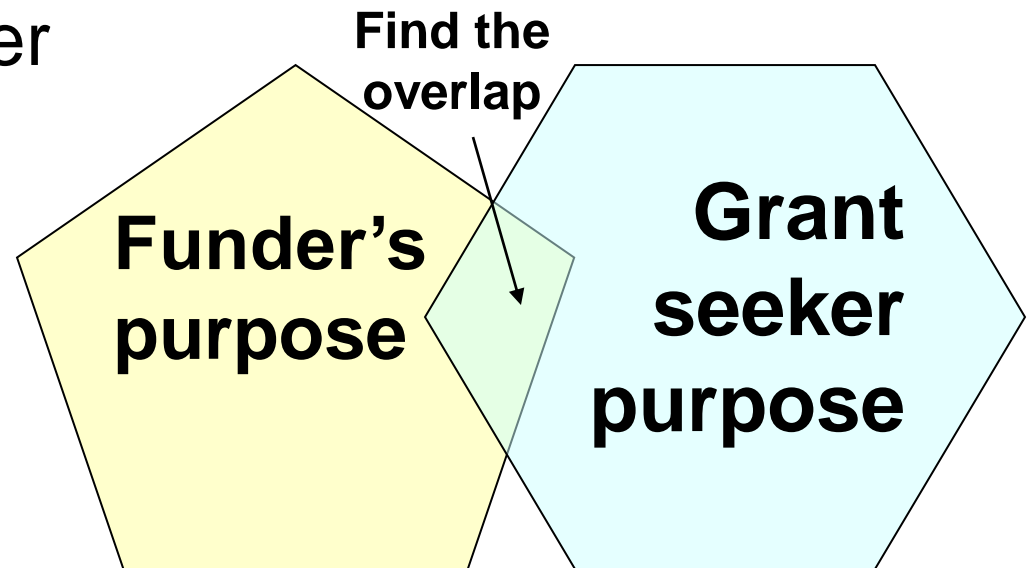

- Identify grants that match
- Get a phone number
- Call to discuss

Which one of these priorities do you align with?

Eligibility

- Not-for-profit – constituted
- Legal status – incorporated or comparable
- Purposes – provide services or support
- Reported on previous completed grants
- Specific grants – specific requirements

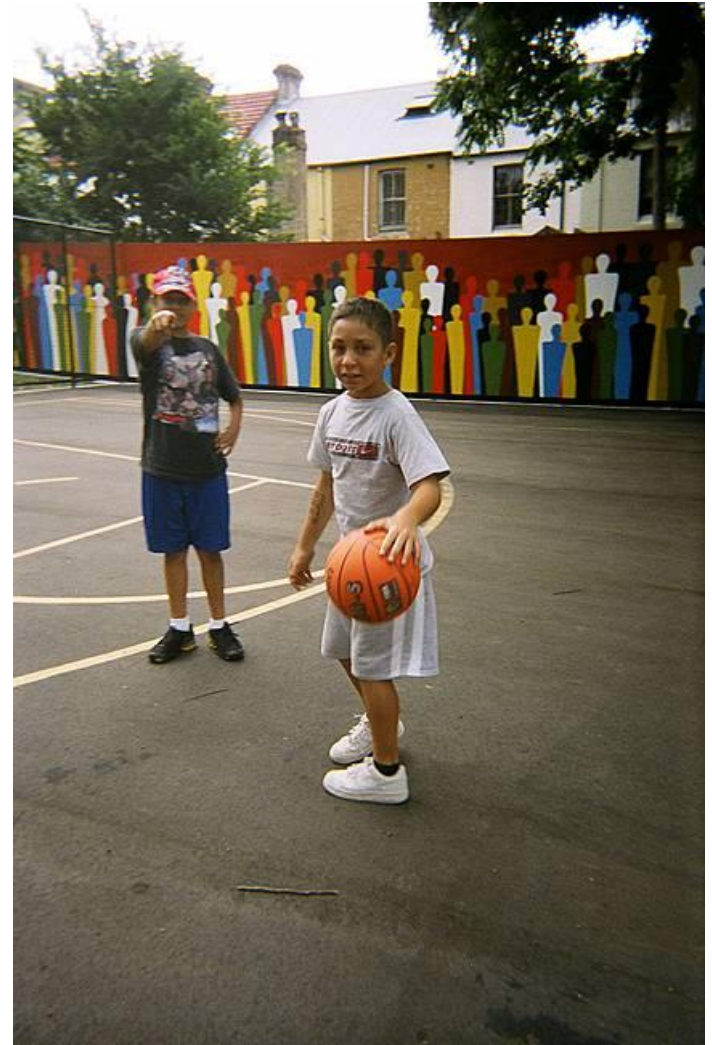


Application Process

- Read the guidelines – check the closing date
- Plan – discuss with committee
- Research – call to clarify concerns
- Gather documentation – organise information
- Complete the form – answer all questions

Community Grants

National Youth Week Grants

- Funding to run activities and events during National Youth Week (10 to 19 April 2015)
- Available for government, non-government, and local council organisations working directly with young people
- Up to \$2,000 for individual organisations and up to \$4,000 for collaborative activities involving two or more organisations

Community Grants

Leap Program Grants

- LEAP = Learning, Engagement and Partnerships
- Two year pilot
- 12 month programs supporting young people aged 12-25 to achieve their goals and connect with the community
- One off grants up to \$15,000
- Round Two opened May 2014, closing on 7 July
- Total funding pool of \$430,000

Community Grants

Youth Volunteer Scholarships

- One-off grants up to \$3,000
- For young South Australians, aged 25 years and under, who volunteer to help in the community.
- \$25,000 is available for grants each year
- For assistance with tuition fees
- Average grant size is \$1,000
- Applications are now open and close on Friday 25 July 2014

Community Grants

Volunteer Support Fund

- One-off grants up to \$3,000
- Programs and equipment
- \$150,000 is available for grants each year
- Average grant size is \$1,500
- Opens for applications in August each year

Community Grants

Volunteer Training Grants

- To deliver free training courses for volunteers and volunteer managers
- \$100,000 is available in training grants this year
- Grants of up to \$10,000 for eligible South Australian organisations e.g. volunteer resource centers, councils, training providers and not-for-profit incorporated community organisations.
- Applications will open in February 2015

Community Grants

Multicultural Grants

- One-off grants up to \$15,000
- Programs, events, equipment
- \$650,000 is available in grants each year
- Average grant size is between \$2,000 - \$4,000
- Apply anytime, no closing date
- Applications up to 8 -10 weeks to assess
- Phone 1300 239 468

Community Grants

Community Benefit SA

- One-off projects up to \$50,000
- Facilities, equipment and programs
- \$3.8m available for grants each year
- Average grant size is \$15,000
- Apply anytime, no closing date
- Applications take 12 weeks to assess
- Phone 1300 650 985

Assessment Process

- Application is complete
- Applicant is eligible
- Documentation is provided
- Funder's purpose is matched
- Specific grants – specific assessment criteria
